WHAT IS THE GO CENTER?

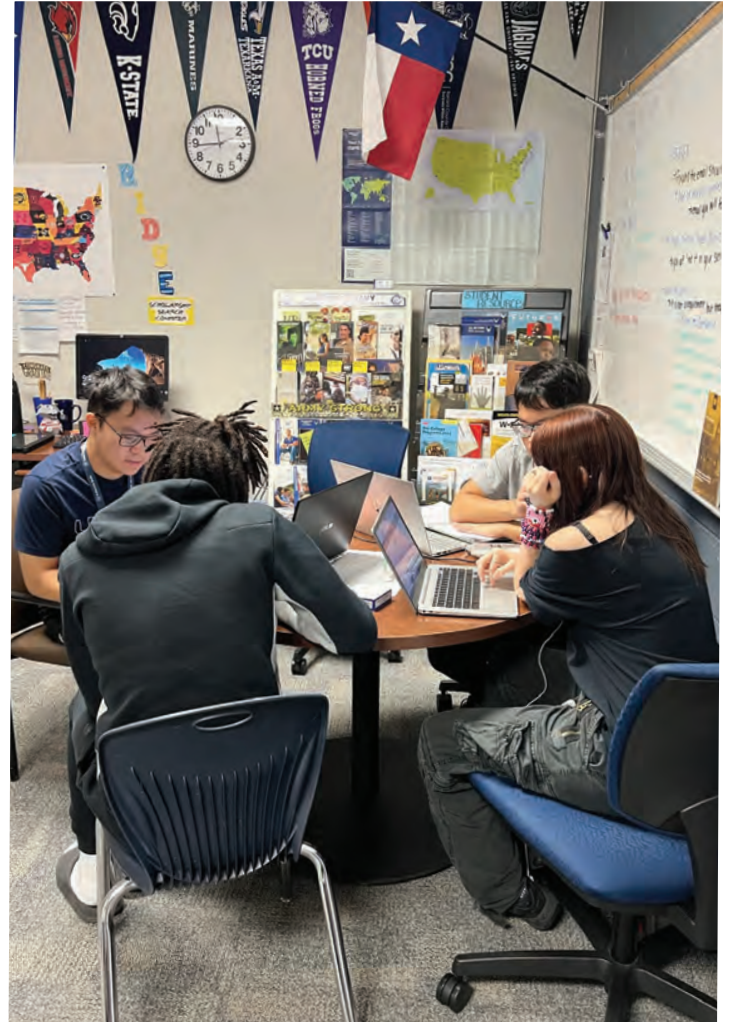
GO Centers are college- and career-focused sites located within schools that create and promote a college-going culture. Students at all grade levels can learn about careers and college preparation in the GO Center. This consists of financial aid, scholarship search, college applications and more.

GO CENTER MENTORS

inspirED mentors are students at Dallas Baptist University, Tarrant County College, Texas Wesleyan University, UT Arlington and UT Dallas. They work one-on-one with students to help them plan for every step leading up to college.

PERFORMANCE

Most of GO Center services from 2023-2024 exceeded the numbers from the previous year. We expanded our partnership with schools and districts to support the HB3 mandate for FAFSA completion.

Mentors

inspirED hires work-study students to serve as GO Center mentors at high schools and community-based centers throughout Arlington, Kennedale and Mansfield. Much of the work our mentors do focuses on assisting students and parents through the college process from start to finish.

Through monthly trainings, meetings and professional development, inspirED works to ensure our mentors leave the program ready for their first professional job. Topics include professional communication, soft skills, resume assistance and more.
